A Quick Guide to ASA's Business Valuation (BV) Accreditation Program

It's as easy as One, Two, Three.

Step 1: Become a Candidate Member of ASA

- Pass ASA's Online Ethics Exam;
- Pass USPAP Exam (if applicable)

Step 2: Complete Education Requirements

- Pass the four BV Principles of Valuation (POV) Courses (BV201-204) OR
- Pass BV 8-Hour Challenge Exam OR
- Have approved education equivalency

Step 3: Apply for Accredited Member (AM) Designation

Candidates who have met the AM accreditation criteria are ready to submit an online accreditation application which includes:*

- Proof of college education or Education Equivalency Form
- An Appraisal Experience Log documenting two (2) years of full-time experience
- A current USPAP certificate (if required)
- Submission of completed online accreditation application
