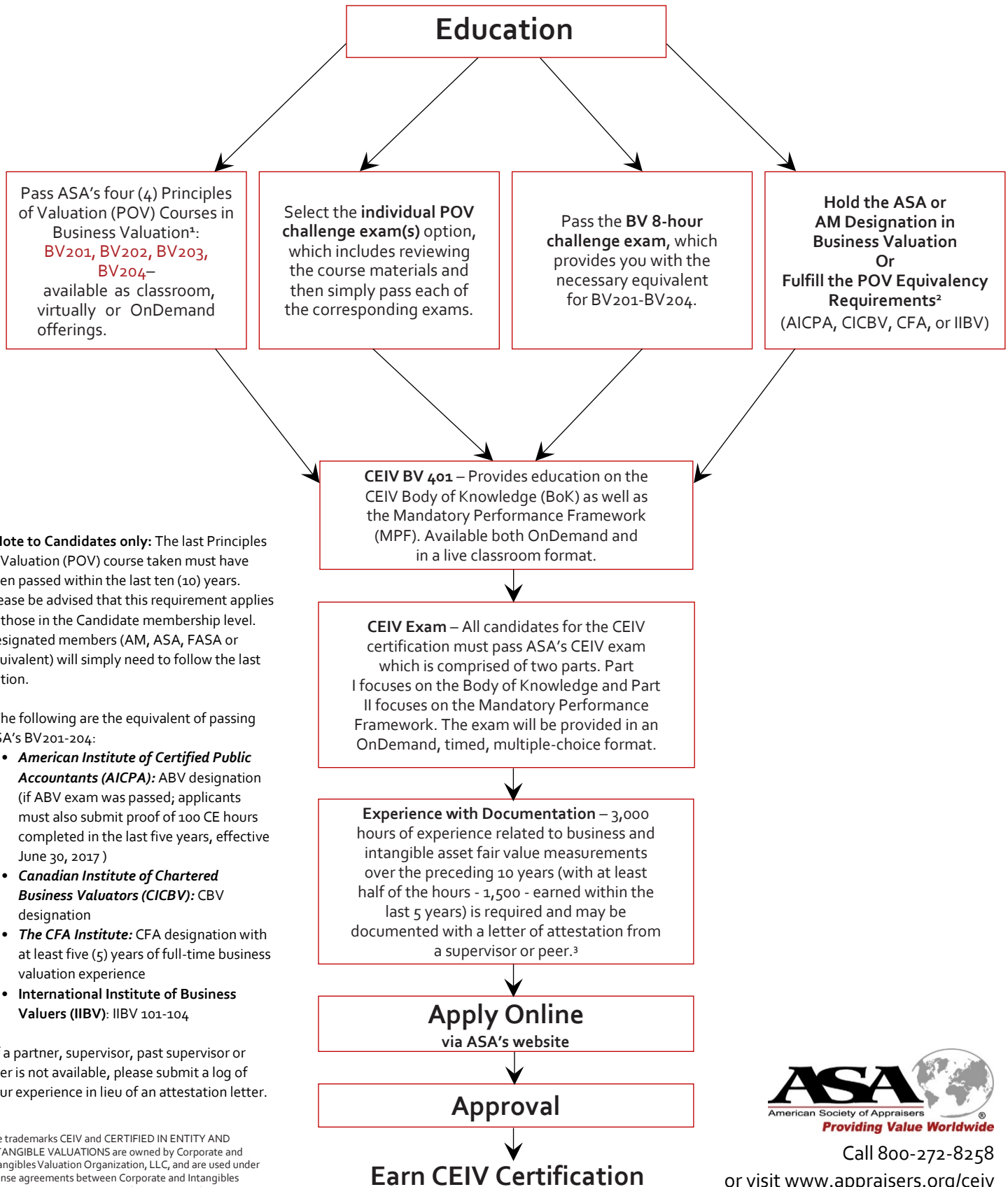

Certified in Entity and Intangible Valuation™ (CEIV™) Credential



¹ **Note to Candidates only:** The last Principles of Valuation (POV) course taken must have been passed within the last ten (10) years. Please be advised that this requirement applies to those in the Candidate membership level. Designated members (AM, ASA, FASA or equivalent) will simply need to follow the last option.

² The following are the equivalent of passing ASA's BV201-204:

- **American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA):** ABV designation (if ABV exam was passed; applicants must also submit proof of 100 CE hours completed in the last five years, effective June 30, 2017)
- **Canadian Institute of Chartered Business Valuators (CICBV):** CBV designation
- **The CFA Institute:** CFA designation with at least five (5) years of full-time business valuation experience
- **International Institute of Business Valuers (IIBV):** IIBV 101-104

³ If a partner, supervisor, past supervisor or peer is not available, please submit a log of your experience in lieu of an attestation letter.
