Experience Log for CEIV

If you are unable to obtain an experience attestation letter from a supervisor, former supervisor or peer, you will need to submit an experience log along with your CEIV application. Experience logs are common in the business world and are an excellent tool to keep track of assignments. The sample log shown below is one example (the definitions may or may not apply to your type of appraisal assignment). You should use this as a guide to develop a log that best suits your needs and your type of work. This appraisal experience log will help ASA's International Board of Examiners to verify your fair value-related experience. Your log should only cover the five-year period prior to your application for the CEIV credential.

• Date—Date of the appraisal report

As of—Effective date of value

- Interest—Interest being valued (only if applicable to your discipline)
- Property Type—Must be appropriate to the discipline in which certification is being sought
- Purpose—Purpose of the appraisal
- Value—Total appraised value
