

Policy on Endorsements During ASA's Campaign Election Period

Adopted by the ASA Board of Governors on March 22, 2014.

Members of the Board of Governors, including the Parliamentarian, Legal Counsel, and the Executive Vice President shall not formally endorse any candidate for any elected position of the Society during the election campaign period. A formal endorsement is defined as any message in support of a candidate in written or electronic form.

Any candidate claiming an endorsement from an individual must be able to provide written confirmation from the endorsing party if asked to do so.
