#### For Designated Members of NAAA:

#### Step 1: Become a Candidate Member of ASA

- Pass ASA's Online Ethics Exam;
- Pass USPAP Exam (if applicable)

#### Step 2: Complete Education Requirements

• Hold the appropriate NAAA designation

## Step 3: Apply for Accredited Senior Appraiser (ASA) Designation

Candidates may submit an online accreditation application to include:\*

- A copy of your NAAA designation documentation
- A current USPAP certificate (if required)
- Documentation indicating education courses completed at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU) or other equivalent education
- Completion of the online accreditation application process
