### For Certified Appraiser Members of ISTAT:

#### Step 1: Become a Candidate Member of ASA

- Complete ASA's online membership application
- Pass USPAP Exam (if applicable) and
- Pass ASA's Online Ethics Exam

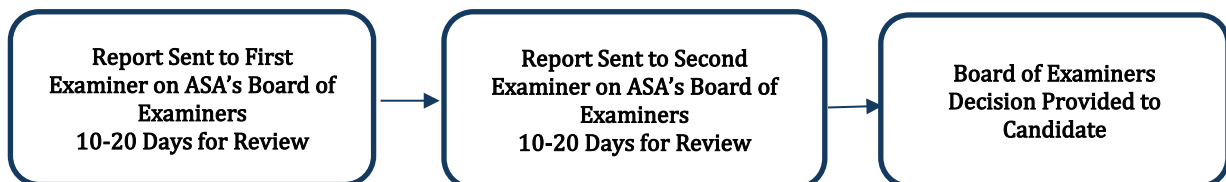
#### Step 2: Apply for Accredited Member (AM) Designation

Candidates may submit an online accreditation application to include:\*

- Documentation of their ISTAT Certified Appraiser Credential
- Documentation of up-to-date USPAP Certificate (if applicable)
- A current Resume/CV
- Upload one (1) narrative, appraisal report performed in the last two (2) years (this refers to the report submission date, not the valuation date. The report must be an actual report that was prepared for a client); and
- Upload a completed [MTS Appraisal Report Checklist](#) to accompany your appraisal report.
