Submit your educational documentation for a pre-review to determine its equivalency toward the **thirty (30) semester hours of college level education requirement**. Submit to [credentials@appraisers.org](mailto:credentials@appraisers.org).

### Join ASA and Move to Candidate Status

- Apply for ASA membership
- Submit proof of valid USPAP
- Pass the ASA ethics exam

### Accreditation

*The following will be needed to apply online:*

- Education requirements: ME 201ACS – 204ACS
- Ensure your USPAP certificate on file with ASA is up to date.
- Upload one (1) narrative appraisal report that was completed within the past two (2) years. This report must be an actual report that was completed for a client.
- Upload documentation of at least thirty (30) semester hours of college-level education (diploma, transcript, etc.)
- Upload an appraisal experience log documenting two (2) years of full-time experience for the Accredited Member (AM) designation or five (5) years of full-time experience for the Accredited Senior Appraiser (ASA) designation.
