A Quick Guide to ASA's Real Property (RP) Accreditation Program for SRAs

It's as easy as One, Two, Three.

Step 1: Become a Candidate Member of ASA

- Pass ASA's Online Ethics Exam
- Pass USPAP Exam (if applicable) *

*USPAP requirement may be met by providing a copy of your valid state RP license

Step 2: Provide SRA Documentation

- Provide your SRA designation certificate
- Provide a copy of your valid RP state license
- Complete the online accreditation application

Step 3: International Board of Examine Review

- Your completed application will be sent to a reviewer on ASA's International Board of Examiners for review
- Once that review has been completed (usually less than ten (10) days, you will receive your ASA designation
