Develop the skills necessary to build a career in the appraisal of personal property and the collecting of fine art, decorative art, antiques, furniture, coins, stamps, and more. Through lectures, optional field trips, and the use of the college's Neuberger Museum of Art—among the 10 largest university museums in the country—learn the history and skills necessary to appraise and/or collect a wide range of items with assurance and competence.

All classes are taught by accredited senior appraisers. Students who successfully complete the four required classes are awarded a certificate by Purchase College SUNY School of Liberal Studies & Continuing Education, reflecting 13 continuing education units (CEUs).

Upon completion of the certificate, you will have taken the first step toward (a) becoming an appraiser or working as an appraisal expert in a gallery, auction house, or insurance company and (b) qualifying for eventual accreditation and membership in ASA.



Introduction to Personal Property Valuation (PP201): May 30-June 2, 2020

Learn general valuation theory, basic appraisal terminology, and economic concepts that apply to valuation. Become acquainted with the appraisal process, ethical concerns of the appraiser, and the *Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice (USPAP)*, the professional standards of the appraiser.

Development of a Personal Property Appraisal: Research and Analysis (PP202): June 3-6, 2020

Understand the appraisal process, from identifying the appraisal problem through developing the "scope of work" to solve the problem. Expand your appraisal terminology, and gain knowledge about the market research and analysis methods needed to reach conclusions of value.

Communication of a Personal Property Appraisal: Report Writing (PP203): June 7-10, 2020

Explore the basics of communicating an appraisal as a written report. Understand the required elements of an appraisal report, and obtain guidance on organizing a document that presents a logical argument for value. Learn to use proper appraisal terminology and research methodology to complete your appraisal report.

Personal Property Valuation: The Legal and Commercial Environments (PP204): June 11-14, 2020

Investigate compliance with laws and regulations, and expand your understanding of professional standards and ethical requirements. Use analysis techniques for concluding fair market value. Gain additional insight into the auction market, the insurance industry, how tort law affects appraisers, and legal precedents on which many appraisal issues are based.
