COVID-19 Impact on License Renewal:

Based on information obtained from the Appraisal Subcommittee, the AQB Criteria states that state appraiser regulatory agencies may allow credential holders impacted by a state or federally declared disaster that occurs within 90 days prior to the end of the continuing education cycle to remain active status for a period of up to 90 days after the end of the credential holder's continuing education cycle, pending completion of all continuing education requirements.

Therefore, **ALL** licenses that currently are at an **ACTIVE or INACTIVE status** and have an expiration date of **6/30/2020** will be extended by 90 days. A new license will be mailed soon reflecting the new expiration date.

As a reminder, this does not alleviate you from renewing your license on or before the new expiration date. Renewal information will be sent out three months prior as is standard practice.

**This does not apply to Real Estate Appraiser Trainee OR Appraisal Management Company licenses.**
